SPAY/NEUTER MYTHS

MYTH: Neutering/Spaying my pet causes negative behavioral changes.

FACT: Just the opposite! Neutering can help avoid some aggression, dominance, marking in pets.

MYTH: My breeder says spaying and neutering my pet is unhealthy for them.

FACT: Neutering your male animal can actually prevent from certain cancers, such as testicular cancer, and prostate problems. Spaying your female pet prevents uterine infections and cancers such as breast cancer in as many as 50% of dogs, and 90% of cats!

MYTH: Spaying and Neutering is too expensive!

FACT: The cost of a neuter/spay procedure is not comparable to the cost of raising and caring for litters. The cost of a spay or neuter procedure is also much less expensive than surgery and possible chemo if your loved one gets cancer and/or infections
